Project rationale	The proposed project will focus on the role of smaller cities within a met-			

ropolitan area in a low-carbon economy. How can carbon emissions be reduced by development and growth in edge cities?

How do we work to include all levels of government in a metropolitan area as well as stakeholders (i.e multilevel governance, participatory planning, polycentric development)?

#### The project will be structured around three topics:

- 1. Attractive edge cities and business development: Can we reduce carbon emissions in metropolitan areas by facilitating business development in edge cities? i.e. start-up strategies and start up hubs, mixed land use strategies and by reducing transport need.
- 2. Accessible edge cities and innovative mobility: Can we reduce carbon emissions in metropolitan areas by employing intelligent low carbon solutions in edge cities? i.e. first and last mile solutions, transport on demand, electric and hydrogen vehicles.
- 3. Sustainable edge cities and renewable energy: Can we reduce carbon emissions in metropolitan areas by employing innovative enery efficiency solutions in edge cities? i.e circular approach, smart grid.

# **Project aim**

Improve policies and their implementation to facilitate for a low-carbon development in edge cities.

#### **Project objectives**

Exchange experience, good practices and tools for urban planning in smaller cities within metropolitan areas

Integration of good practices into regional plans and action plans

#### **Activities**

Interregional events: the project will include a series of thematic workshops and study tours aimed at exchanging experience to identify good practice, peer to peer learning and the development of innovative approaches.

Local events: the local events will aim to disseminate the findings of the interregional events amongst partners at local level thorugh regional stakeholder meetings

### **Outputs**

The main outputs of the projects are expected to be:

- Interregional workshops
- Regional stakeholder meetings
- Political meetings and conferences
- Action Plans indicating actions and investmensts
- In depth analyses
- Analyses of the situation in partner regions
