The DHP Conservation company description

DHP Conservation Ltd. (hereinafter DHP) is a consultancy company, founded in 2014. DHP has permanent staff of 4 people and cooperates with other ad hoc fellow experts.

The main goals of DHP are:

- **Expert and consultancy services in protection and conservation of natural resources:** DHP is active mainly in the EU-candidate and the EU-cooperating countries with a special focus on the implementation of the EU Nature legislation (esp. Birds and Habitats Directives) and other relevant policies. Concurrently, DHP provides expertise in the field of protected areas (e.g. setting conservation objectives and measures) at national and local level. In this respect, DHP benefits from its direct cooperation with the European Commission (DG ENV).
- **Support in a project development and a corporate social responsibility in the natural resources protection:** the DHP team is experienced in capability development as well as in project planning and development, primarily for projects supported from EU structural funds and the LIFE programme. DHP offers services not only in preparation of project proposals but first of all, in defining goals and ways how to achieve them.
- **Communication, Conflict Resolution, and Management:** DHP offers services in addressing common public as well as various interest groups and managing dialogue among parties with different positions and interests. The DHP experts have an experience with facilitation of meetings, discussions, public debates and awareness raising. They help to translate environmental issues to a language understandable to business, public administration, and institutions not commonly coming into contact with nature protection issues.
